

## Sneaky Conversations™ Score Sheet

This score sheet is for use with Round Play. (We mention Continuous Play, in case you missed it when reading the rules.) If you have more than 6 players or plan to play more than 30 rounds (for the marathoners), just use more score sheets. You can download more score sheets at [sneakyconversations.com](http://sneakyconversations.com).

**Method 1: Round Play**

- For Accumulated Points scoring, record the score for each player from each round by counting the number of Sneak Cards in each Personal Discard Pile. Each card is worth one point. The player with the lowest total points wins the game.
- For Rounds Won scoring, award one point to the player who wins each round by counting the number of Sneak Cards in each Personal Discard Pile. Each card is worth one point. The player with the lowest number of points wins the round. The player who won the most rounds wins the game. You can allow carry-overs or choose not to award a round winner when ties occur.

**Method 2: Continuous Play**

- For Accumulated Points Scoring, each player counts the number of Sneak Cards they have collected in their Personal Discard Pile at the end of the game. Each Sneak Card is worth one point. The player with the lowest number of accumulated points wins the game.
- For Get Rid of Them Scoring, the winner is the first player to get rid of their accumulated Sneak Cards. This method is best for parties. See How to Play for details..
